MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
MARCH 10, 2021**

The Council of the City of Louisburg, Kansas met at 7:00 p.m. in special session via Zoom. Mayor Marty Southard presiding.

Item 1. City Utilities Low-Interest Loan Fund Application

Steve Town moved, Kevin Vohs seconded, to adopt Resolution 03-10-2021A, Authorizing the City of Louisburg to apply for the City Utility Low-Interest Loan Program from the State of Kansas to finance extraordinary natural gas costs incurred during the during the extreme weather event of February 2021, with a loan amount totaling \$2,639,994 over a term of 10 years with bi-annual payments. Motion passed 4-0.

Item 2. 2021 Budget Amendment

Sandy Harris moved, Donna Cook seconded, to approve for publication the budget amendment presented. Motion passed 4-0.

Steve Town moved, Sandy Harris seconded, to adopt Resolution 03-10-2021B, to return previously transferred funds from Natural Gas Capital Improvement Fund to Natural Gas Fund pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1,118, funds totaling \$1,000,000. Motion passed 4-0.
