

Louisburg History Hunt

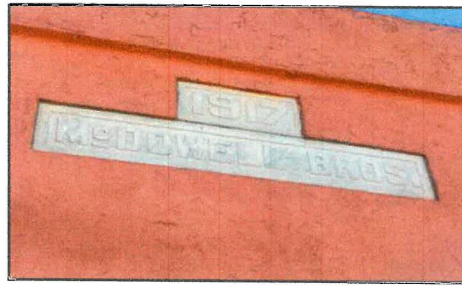
Celebrated in May each year, Historic Preservation Month is a great time to look high and low to find hints to Louisburg's past. The Louisburg Historic Preservation Commission is sponsoring a scavenger hunt of architectural features in (and within a block of) the Historic Downtown area. How many of the 10 features can you find?

1. The Louisburg History Hunt will be open during May 2023 closing Wednesday May 31st at 4:30 pm. The winner will be determined by a drawing from all correct entries, and will be announced at the June 7th, 6:30 pm meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission at Louisburg City Hall.
2. Print a copy of the pictures from the City of Louisburg website (www.louisburgkansas.gov), or pick up a copy at City Hall (215 S. Broadway).
3. Search Louisburg's historic downtown for the architectural features (on or within a block of Broadway).
4. For each feature, #'s 1-10, write the address of the building, or the name of the current business.
5. Email your numbered list of the buildings to: History.Hunt.2023@gmail.com or drop your entry by City Hall during business hours.
6. Don't forget to include your name and email address or phone number to notify you if you are the winner.
7. When the contest is over, the names of the buildings and a little history about each will be posted on the City Of Louisburg Facebook page. The name of the winner will also be posted.
