


Louisburg Aquatic Center Survey 2018

How respondents described themselves. Many chose multiple categories: single with children; couple with children; or senior with grandchildren




What did they visit for?

Where do they live?




Survey note: Numbers may not add up depending on how respondents completed questionnaire. In the comment section, like comments have been grouped rather than repeated but no comments were omitted from report.


Which entry method is utilized:

How were the items priced?




Did you like the variety of items available?




